MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This **Memorandum of Understanding** (herein after called as the 'MOU') is entered into on this the 28th day of December month 2022 (Date 28-12-2022), by and between **ExcelR Solutions**, (herein after referred as '**First Party**')

And

K. C College of Engineering & Management Studies & Research (herein after referred to as "**Second Party**", (First Party and Second Party are here in after jointly referred to as '**Parties**' and individually as '**Party**')

WHEREAS:

1. First Party is a EdTech company: ExcelR Solutions
2. First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and cooperation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
3. The Parties intend to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within the area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.
4. Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL
PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO
AGREE AS FOLLOWS:**

CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

5. Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings.
6. First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to the second party in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.
7. The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.
8. ExcelR would be the training delivery partner for the second party on various trending technologies
9. Training & Development and dissemination of knowledge for students of second party & affiliated colleges and employees of both the organizations.
10. ExcelR would work with incubation centers/ innovation cells of second party (Case to case basis), to formulate the business cases and data collection process from various industry and academic bodies that are associated with the second party
11. Cooperation between both parties would be extended to any other area which may be mutually beneficial to both organizations.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MoU

12. The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in the technological up-gradation, innovation, and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
13. Curriculum Design: First Party will give valuable input to the Second Party in teaching/training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
14. Software Technologies Training: The first party will provide the training to the students and Faculties of the second party on different technologies like Data Science, Data Analyst, Artificial Intelligence, Tableau, Python, etc., Research and Development
15. Skill Development Programs: First Party to train the students of the second Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
16. Guest Lectures: First Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the second Party on the technology trends and in-house requirements.

17. Faculty Development Programs: First Party to train the faculties of the second Party for imparting training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.
18. Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein
19. There is no financial commitment on the part of the second party to enroll the students and faculties for the different free trainings run by the first party under Everyday Learning Initiation.
20. The first party would extend the help in providing artifacts such as training records and certificates to the second party upon a written request from the second party. This information is limited to only the students of the second party and at the discretion of the first party.
21. In case, the second party wants to conduct customized commercial training then this agreement can be amended, adding annexure with mutually agreed terms.

CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

22. The first party will have the sole rights on the curriculum and related content provided in the training and it cannot be replicated or copied without the consent of the first party.
23. Confidentiality: Except as may otherwise be required by law, each party will hold confidential, during and after the term of this Agreement, any confidential information disclosed to it or its representatives, and will not disclose any such confidential information to any third party.

CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY

24. The period of the agreement is valid for a period of 2 years from the date of signing of this agreement
25. This agreement will be valid only at the intentions of the parties involved therein, this MOU could be dissolved or cancelled by either party any time by giving 30 days' notice and shall not have any legal bindings in nature. should either or all the parties to it opt to not act upon, the MOU loses its validity.

CLAUSE 5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

26. It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This MOU has been made and executed at Thane on 1st of February 2023

BETWEEN

K C College of Engineering & Management Studies and Research Thane Engineering & Management College having its campus at Thane, represented through the Principal of the College Prof. (Dr.) Vilas Nitware, herein after called the First Part or the First Party, which unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, will include its Successors-in-interest and assigns, on the ONE PART.

AND

International Association for Human Values (IAHV) with its headquarters at 216-C, Humayunpur, Opp. B-6/98, Safdarjung Enclave, New Delhi - 110029 and represented by its Project Manager, Pramila Vijayakumar hereinafter called the Second Part or the Second Party, which unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, will include its successors-in-interest and assigns, on the OTHER PART.

WHEREAS, the first party has been established under University of Mumbai to provide education and research in various branches of Engineering and to disseminate knowledge in these branches and is engaged in the providing education at affordable cost to the people of this country.

AND WHEREAS, the second party is a not-for-profit organization engaging in nationwide initiatives addressing disaster relief, skills training leading to employability and entrepreneurship, health, WASH (Water, Sanitation and Hygiene), education, and environmental sustainability.



NOW THEREFORE, the aforementioned parties have agreed to the terms and conditions as mentioned hereinafter in order to provide employability training sessions for the final year students to upskill them so that they are better prepared to get suitable job opportunities and to enter the workforce.

Both the parties believe that close cooperation between the two organizations would be a major benefit to the student community.

I. OBJECTIVES

1. Both parties share a common intent to disseminate and advance knowledge; and to upskill final year students across all disciplines.
2. This collaboration is intended to provide the students opportunities and exposure to help them to be better prepared for job opportunities and to enter the work force.
3. The collaboration between the two institutions shall be as follows:
 - a) The College and IAHV shall work together to create a training schedule for the final year students.
 - b) The proposed activity schedule shall not affect the academic schedule of the college.
 - c) The College shall make the students available as per the agreed schedule and shall provide classroom space in the college as required for the training.
 - d) IAHV shall conduct the employability training program for the students.
 - e) Each training session shall be for a minimum of 60 students and at least two such programs shall be done (total 120 students).
 - f) IAHV shall have the option to not conduct the sessions if the minimum number of students are not present for the session.
 - g) IAHV shall also provide career guidance to students where possible.
 - h) IAHV shall also provide opportunities for students to interact with the industry where possible.
 - i) Once the student is placed by the College the same will be communicated to IAHV through College letter heads signed by Principal/Offer letters.
 - j) The data shared with IAHV shall be kept confidential and shall only be used to report the success of the program to IAHV's donors.
 - k) IAHV shall use appropriate branding of IAHV's donors during the training



sessions.

- 1) The College and IAHV can change the scope of the program after mutual discussions.

II. NATURE AND SCOPE OF UNDERSTANDING

Both parties shall not render any other service other than that mentioned in this MOU, unless otherwise agreed upon by the parties.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS


1. This MOU is valid for a period of one year which can be renewed further from time to time as per the mutually agreed terms and conditions.
2. Both the Parties may terminate the MOU at any time by giving 2 months' notice in advance to the other party.
3. The students to follow the code of conduct to help maintain the reverential ambiance of the respective institutions.
4. There shall not be any financial commitment by both parties as a part of this engagement.
5. If a party's opinion that a conflict of interest has arisen while carrying out the Services including by reason of change in the party's ownership, copyright or other scenarios, then a party shall be entitled to rescind the Agreement by written notice to another party.
6. The Parties herein agree that the provisions pertaining to confidentiality shall continue even after the termination of the MOU for a period of 6 months.
7. This MOU may be modified in writing by mutual consent of authorized officials from the two Parties. This MOU shall become effective upon signature by the authorized officials from both the partners and shall remain effective until modified or terminated by any one of the partners by mutual consent.
8. This MOU shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the Indian laws and shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of Mumbai. For any dispute or difference arising under this MOU, the parties shall endeavor to resolve the same in good faith through mutual dialogue/discussions/negotiations. In the event of failure of such dialogue/discussions/negotiations, the matter shall be referred to a binding arbitration



under the rules of arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. The dispute between the parties shall be adjudicated by a Sole Arbitrator to be nominated by the parties herein on mutual consent. The arbitration shall be in English language and the venue of arbitration shall be at Mumbai, India. The costs of such arbitration shall be borne on the basis of the award passed by the arbitrators.

9. All publications whether through print or any other media connected with the activities pertaining to this MOU will be done after review and express approval of both the parties herein.

A. NON-BINDING TERMS.

The terms and objectives set forth in Exhibit A shall be used for discussion purposes only and shall not be deemed to create any rights or obligations for or on behalf of any Party.

B. BINDING TERMS

The Parties hereby acknowledge and agree that the following subsections under this Section B (Binding Terms) shall be binding and create legal rights and obligations on the Parties.

1. Confidentiality

In this MOU "Confidential Information" means any information or data, irrespective of the form and nature thereof, that is material to the Party disclosing such information ("Discloser") to the other Party ("Recipient"), including, but not limited to technical know how, specifications, designs, models, software, techniques, drawings, processes, as well as industrial and intellectual property rights, business information, trade secrets, customer lists, financial information, process, costs, sales and marketing plans, information posted on their respective websites or any other information with the Recipient knows or reasonably ought to know is confidential, proprietary or trade secret information of the Discloser.

The Recipient shall at all times, both during the term of this MOU and for a period of at least three (3) years after its expiration or termination, keep in trust and confidence all such Confidential Information, and shall not use such Confidential Information other than for the purpose of fulfilling its obligations under this MOU, nor shall the Recipient disclose any such Confidential Information to any third party without the Disclosing Party's prior written consent. Upon termination of this MOU or written request from the Discloser, the Recipient shall, within fifteen (15) days from such termination or request, return all Confidential Information and any and all copies thereof to the Discloser, or at the Discloser's option, destroy the Confidential Information and any and all copies thereof, and certify such destruction

The obligations of confidentiality set forth herein shall not apply to information which;

- a. Was rightfully in possession of or known to the Recipient without any obligation of confidentiality prior to receiving it from the Discloser;
- b. Is, or subsequently becomes, legally and publicly available without breach of this MOU;
- c. Is rightfully obtained by the Recipient from a source other than the Discloser, without any obligation of confidentiality; or
- d. Is developed by or for the Recipient without use of the Confidential Information.

The Recipient may only disclose Confidential Information pursuant to a valid order issued by a court or governmental agency, provided that the Recipient provides the Discloser:

- a. Prior written notice of such obligation; and
- b. The opportunity to oppose such disclosure or obtain a protective order.

The Confidential Information shall remain the property of the Discloser and no license to any existing or future intellectual property rights or Confidential Information is granted or implied under this MOU.

All Confidential Information is provided "AS IS". The Discloser shall not be liable for any inaccuracy or completeness of the Confidential Information, nor are there any express or implied representations or warranties by either party to the other, including with respect to the infringement of any intellectual property rights or any right of privacy, or any rights of third persons.

2. **Scope**

The scope of this MOU does not cover any development work, testing, licensing, distribution, support, sales, or maintenance. Should the Parties decide to pursue such matter that is outside the scope of this MOU, the Parties shall enter into a development, license, distribution, or other appropriate written agreement(s) accordingly.

3. **Publicity**

The Parties hereby agree that no press release or other public announcements regarding this MOU or any agreements contemplated thereby shall be made without prior review and written agreement signed by a duly authorized representative of the other Party.

4. **Term and Termination**

The Parties agree that this MOU shall be effective as of the Effective Date and shall continue in effect until the earliest occurrence of one of the following: (1) the execution of a definitive MOU or definitive agreement relating to the scope of this MOU; (2) written notice by one Party to the other of termination of this MOU; or **thirty six (36) months** from the Effective Date of this MOU. Section B (including all subsections) shall survive any termination of this MOU. Upon expiry of the Term, it is the intention of the Parties to further progress the solutions initiated under this MOU towards overall achievement of the objectives and outcomes contemplated herein. Second party shall, to this extent, endeavor to continue maintaining and promoting such solutions and projects to further the objectives set forth in the MOU.

5. **Limitation of Liability**

Except for liability relating to either Party's breach of the other Party's confidential information or intellectual property rights, in no event shall either Party be liable to the other Party for any direct, indirect, incidental, special, punitive or consequential damages or loss of profits, lost revenue or loss of data.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing in this MOU shall limit the Parties liability for bodily injury or death caused by its negligence or its liability in the tort of deceit.

6. **Intellectual property rights**

Each Party will retain the exclusive rights, title and ownership of all its pre-existing Intellectual Property, Confidential Information and materials (including, without limitation, proprietary ideas, sketches, diagrams, text, know-how, concepts, proofs of concepts, artwork, software, algorithms, methods, processes, identifier codes or other technology) owned or developed by such Party.

7. **Governing laws and jurisdiction**

The Parties shall make efforts in good faith to amicably resolve all disputes as may arise out of or in connection with this MOU. This MOU shall be subject to and governed by the laws of India and the Indian courts shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any claim arising under this **MOU**. Notwithstanding the foregoing, either Party may seek interim injunctive relief in any court of appropriate jurisdiction with respect to any alleged breach of such Party's intellectual property or proprietary rights.

8. **Costs**

Unless otherwise agreed upon in writing, each Party shall bear its own costs and expenses arising in connection with this MOU and the possible negotiations, completion and implementation of definitive Agreements if any, including but not limited to costs of experts, consultants, lawyers and travel expenses.

9. **Amendment**

This MOU may be amended at any time by the mutual written assent of the Parties.

10. **Severability.**

Should any portion of this MOU be determined to be illegal or unenforceable, the remainder of the MOU shall continue in full force and effect, and either party may renegotiate the terms affected by the severance.

The event saw an overwhelming participation of 135 participants. The program ended with 'Vote of Thanks' given by Asst. Prof. S. Bhumadevi.

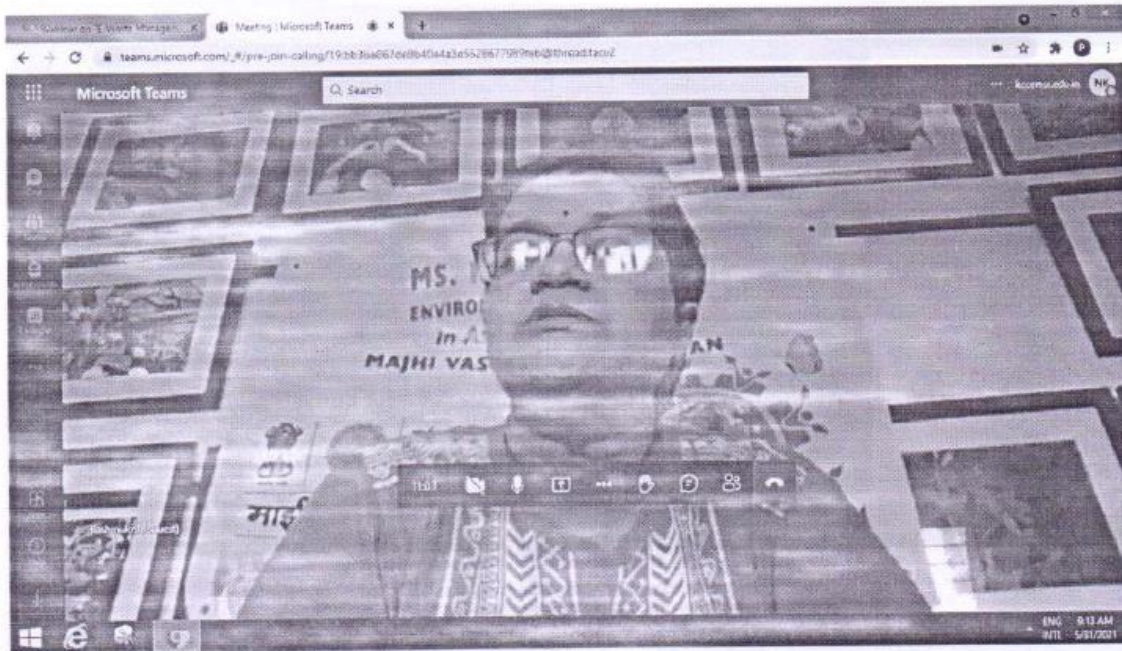

Report on Webinar - "Kitchen & Terrace Gardening"

The Eco Club in association with the Department of Humanities and Applied Sciences and IQAC organized a webinar on "Kitchen & Terrace Gardening" on 23.10.2020.

"When it comes to terrace gardening, many people are interested but they don't know how to start and where to get the resources. Seeds are available at one place while saplings have to be purchased from another place – it is a lot of work. To solve the problem we had kept a webinar on "Kitchen and Terrace Gardening".

The guest speaker was heartily welcomed by Mrs. S Bhumadevi, an Assistant Professor of Department of Humanities and Applied Sciences. The session was taken by Ms. Rashmi Joshi. In her session she explained the introduction to kitchen and terrace gardening and then impressive practical session started, in that she discussed and shown the preparation of soil which is rich in nutrients. The right type of soil is very important as the nutrients decide the growth of the plant. The right mix of soil requires regular soil, compost coir peat (or sand) and vermicompost in equal quantities.

She also discussed about the different types of pots and shown with a small pot and single vegetable and then gradually expand to other veggies. Plants like tomatoes and chillies are easier to grow and do not require much care, so you can start with those. If you want to grow more than beans, chillies, tomatoes, brinjal, okra and lime are also easier to grow. You can also try cucumber, ridge gourd and bottle gourd. Root vegetables like potatoes, onion, radish, carrots, and groundnuts can also be grown but they require a larger area.

Watering regularly is a must. In summers, garden requires watering twice a day. In winters just press the soil with the back of your hand to check the moisture and water accordingly. Also suggested to put vegetable and fruits waste as composed in soil.

The session was very interactive and participants participated enthusiastically. Later she explained about natural pesticides, how to prepare Amrutjal, how to prepare pesticides and which plants will grow in which size of pots. The event saw an overwhelming participation of 86 participants. The program ended with 'Vote of Thanks' given by Asst. Prof. S Bhumadevi.

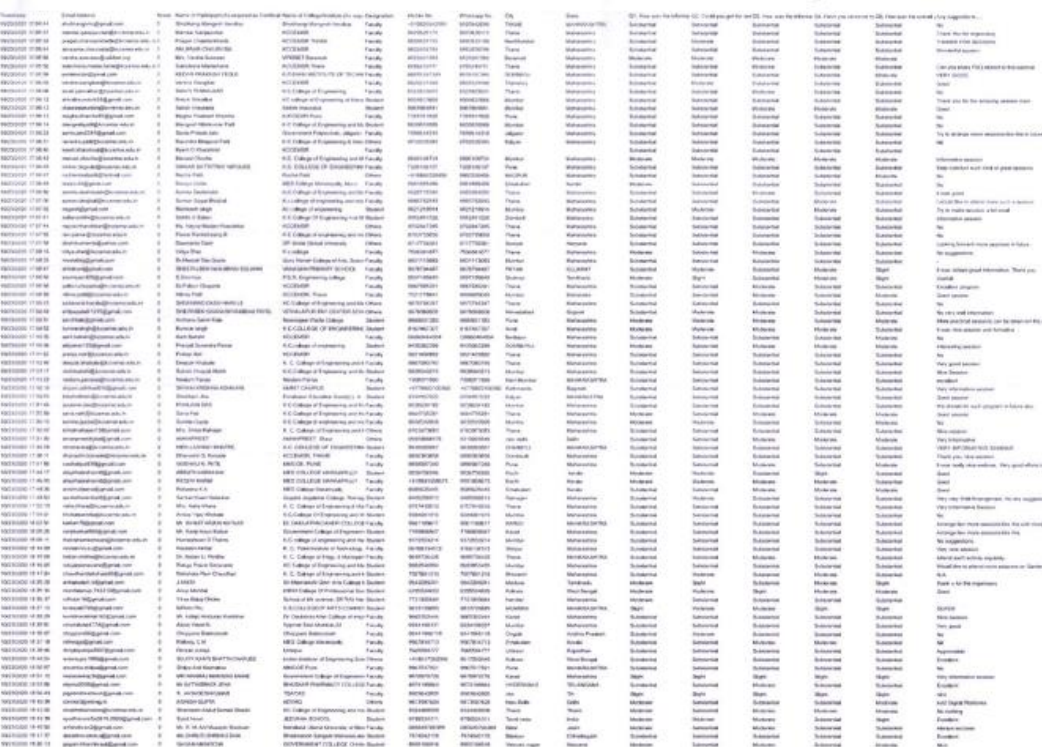

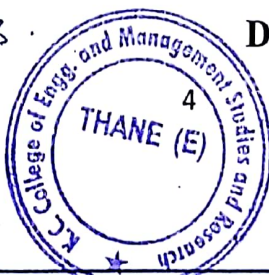

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS UNDER:

1. Objective:

The objective of this MOU is to enable students of KCCEMSR to access resources that would enhance their employability.

2. Period of MOU:

This MOU shall come into force and effect from the date of execution and shall remain valid for a period of One year from such date after which the same may be reviewed by either party. However, if the same is not renewed this arrangement will be deemed terminated on the expiry of the said duration period.

3. Roles & Responsibilities of the College:

6. Commercial:

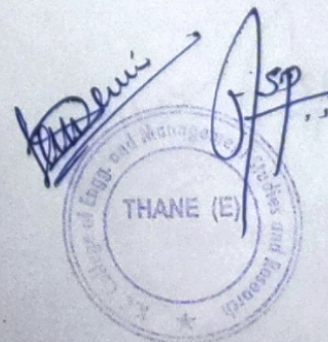
This Training Program is free of cost. GTT shall not charge any fees on whatsoever account/name from the students or the College for conducting the aforesaid training program.

10. Entirety & Amendment:



12. Confidential Information:

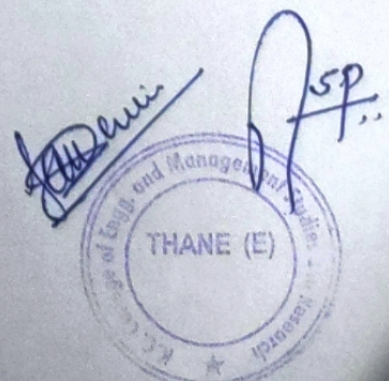

- c. In the event of any of the parties becoming legally compelled to disclose any confidential information, such party shall give sufficient notice to the other party so as to enable the other party to seek a timely protective order or any other appropriate relief. If such an order or other relief cannot be obtained, the party being required to make such a disclosure shall make the disclosure of the Confidential Information only to the extent that is legally required do fit and no further.

13. Force Majeure:

- a. Neither party to this MOU shall be liable for any failure or delay on its part in performing any of its obligations under this MOU, if such failure or delay shall be result of or arising out of Force Majeure conditions and, provided that the party claiming Force Majeure shall use its best efforts to avoid or remove such cause of non-performance and shall fulfil and continue performance hereunder with the utmost dispatch whenever and to the extent such cause or causes are removed.
- b. Any extraordinary event, which cannot be controlled by the parties, shall for the purpose of this MOU be considered as a Force Majeure event. Such events include acts of God, acts or omissions of any Government or agency thereof, compliance with rules, regulations or order of any Government Authority. Provided however, if either party claims that existence of any of the aforesaid conditions is delaying or disabling the performance by said party of its obligations under this MOU, such party shall give immediate notice to the other party of the existence of such conditions whose existence are claimed to delay or disable the performance of obligations as aforesaid.



14. Jurisdiction and Arbitration:

- a. In the event of any dispute or difference between the Parties hereto, the courts in Pune alone shall have exclusive jurisdiction to try any matter arising between the Parties here-to and accordingly both the Parties shall submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts in Pune, Maharashtra.
- b. Any dispute arising out of, in relation to or in respect to this MOU shall be settled through mutual consultation and agreement, by the Parties to this MOU. In case a settlement is not arrived at within fifteen (15) days of reference, the dispute/s shall be referred to a sole arbitrator to be appointed in accordance to the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended from time to time. The place of arbitration shall be Pune, India.
